## Northside High Senior Wins Award in Statewide Manufacturer's Appreciation Art Design Contest



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA - Northside High School senior Michael Busselle was awarded Honorable Mention in the 2018 Manufacturing Appreciation Week (MAW) student art design contest. He was recognized during the MAW Governor's Awards Luncheon on April 12, 2018, at the Georgia International Convention Center in Atlanta.

Busselle was presented a certificate by Gov. Nathan Deal. He also received \$50 and his art was on display at the luncheon. He is pictured with his art and certificate. The awards luncheon is the highlight of MAW, celebrated this year April 9-12.

Students from across the state entered designs featuring Georgia manufacturers and their products. The contest promotes the importance of manufacturing and the potential for students to find fulfilling careers in that sector of the economy. Thousands of students enter the contest each year. Four winners are picked from each category: K - 5th grade; 6th - 8th grade; and 9th - 12th grade.

Co-hosted by the Technical College System of Georgia and the Georgia Department of Economic Development, MAW brings attention to this significant component of Georgia's economy. Central Georgia Technical College serves as the local sponsor of the design contest for its 11-county service area.
