STAR Students & Teachers Honored Jan. 29

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Perry Area and Robins Regional Chambers of Commerce will host the annual Student Teacher Achievement Recognition (STAR) recognition program on **Jan. 29, 2019, at 5:30 p.m.** The program and reception will be at the Eric P. Staples building in Perry at the Board of Education's central office.

During the program, STAR Students and their STAR Teachers will be honored, and the district winner will be announced for the first time. The 2019 STAR Students and Teachers from the Houston County School System are:

- Houston County High: Tien Tran and teacher Laura Byrd;
- Northside High: Symone Crowder and teacher Cherri Nix;
- Perry High: Heidi Hall and teacher Angela Heath;
- Veterans High: Aakash Arora and teacher Jennifer Douglass; and
- Warner Robins High: Emily Howell and teacher Candace Henderson.

The Chambers will present each STAR Student \$100 and a certificate. Their STAR Teachers will also be presented an award and certificate. The District STAR Student will receive an additional \$400, and their STAR Teacher will receive \$100. The system STAR Student and Teacher will be invited to the Region STAR banquet held Mar. 18 at 6:00 p.m. in Macon at Middle Georgia State University. The region winner would next attend the state banquet on April 29 in Atlanta. The Professional Association of Georgia Educators (PAGE) Foundation sponsors, administers and promotes the STAR Program.

The STAR program began in 1958 to focus attention on Georgia's outstanding students and teachers. To obtain the nomination, high school seniors must have the highest score on a single test date on the SAT. Students must also be in the top 10 percent or top 10 students of their class based on grade point average. Each STAR student selects a STAR teacher who has been the most influential to their academic success. STAR students compete for system, region and state-level awards.
