Dr. Mark Scott Honored with Good Government Award



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Dr. Mark Scott, Houston County Superintendent of Schools, was honored by the Robins Regional Chamber of Commerce with the *Sherrill Stafford Good Government Award*. Dr. Scott was surprised with the award during the Chamber’s annual Pinnacle Awards program on Jan. 25, 2018.

Dr. Ivan Allen, President of Central Georgia Technical College, spoke and announced the award. “Dr. Scott is a man who has taken us to great heights” said Dr. Allen. “It is not about statistics for him. We can talk about graduation rates and enrollment that approaches thirty thousand students. He, however, likes to talk about the children. We have a man who is instilling hope in children for tomorrow.”

A plaque was presented to Scott by Allen and Chamber Chairman Michael Chalmers. During his response, he remarked, “It is my privilege to serve as Superintendent of Schools for Houston County. We have the best Board of

Education in the United States. What we do in the community is very important to me. It is my commitment to continue to work as hard as I can to make sure the children are taken care of.”

Dr. Scott has served as superintendent since June 2014. He earned his doctorate at Mercer University as well as a Specialist in Education from Georgia College & State University. Prior to serving at the central office, he was the principal at Northside High School. Dr. Scott served as a middle school principal in Baldwin County.
