Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success

Teachers will

- Teach parents common core strategies for solving two and three digit addition and subtraction to support student learning at home.
- Provide a hundreds chart for students to use at home.
- Use various types of technology (websites, downloadable applications) to enhance student learning in math and reading skills.
- Teach parents word attack strategies for solving unfamiliar words during Family Literacy Night.
- Use differentiated instruction strategies and small groups to meet the individual needs of students.
- Provide list digital resources (websites, apps) to help parents and students at home.
- Assess to monitor student progress weekly and/or bi-weekly.

Parents will

- Attend Math/Reading Jet Parent College Workshops to learn strategies to help students at home.
- Practice addition and subtraction facts with students at least 15 minutes a night.
- Help students with homework using strategies taught in class.
- Encourage students to read at least 30 minutes at home daily.
- Contact the teacher regularly to monitor their child's academic progress.
- Review student agenda daily to complete homework and communicate with teachers.
- Attend parent-teacher conferences.

What is a School-Parent Compact?

A school-parent compact is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers and students will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. This agreement was jointly developed by stakeholders and is reviewed/ revised annually based on feedback from all stakeholders. Compacts will be discussed during parent-teacher conferences.
