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### Lindsey Elementary School 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Focus Areas

- Knowing high frequency sight words
- Retelling a story in sequential order
- Making predictions based on information from a text
- Addition and subtracting fluently
- Understanding place value
- Making sense of real-world word problems

### Teachers will

- Provide students and parents a list of high frequency sight words to practice with at home.
- Provide independent and small group instruction to assist students' individual needs.
- Provide parents with questions and prompts to ask students to help them in retelling a story.
- Be an aid in helping parents learn and understand math strategies in order to help their student with homework.
- Provide parents with frequent report on child's progress.



### Parents will

- Attend parent conferences and workshops to keep up with student progress and learn strategies to help students at home.
- Encourage students to read at home and summarize what they read.
- Assist students with homework using strategies taught in class.
- Practice sight word with students.
- Make sure student comes to school each day prepared with his or her necessary materials.

### Students will

- Use strategies to complete assignments and homework.
- Choose books that are just right.
- Read at home and practice summarizing the reading each night.
- Practice sight words nightly.
- Participate in class.
- Complete all classwork and communicate with the teacher if you need clarification or do not understand a task.
