Teachers will

- Require students to keep a daily journal containing various math and reading problems/questions as well as the strategies to be used for solving.
- Form various strategy groups based on results from benchmark tests and other assessments.
- Model strategies and appropriate responses for students.
- Incorporate technology into the curriculum.
- Provide frequently for parents the various math and reading strategies that are being taught in class.
- Send home multiplication charts and comprehension skills sheets.

Parents will

- Attend parent workshops regularly to receive information on how to help their student at home.
- Monitor student's nightly reading of at least 30 minutes.
- Practice basic math facts skills for at least 15 minutes each night with your student.
- Encourage your student to do their best while at school.
- Have student to use websites, interactive notebook, and additional resources for extra practice and support.

Students will

- Read at least 30 minutes a night.
- Practice basic math facts for at least 15 minutes a night.
- Actively participate in class.
- Keep up with your interactive journals.
- Read actively.
- Practice and apply math and reading strategies when completing homework or other assignments.
- Set goals and monitor their progress.
