## *Teachers, Parents, and Students – Together for Success*

### **Teachers will**

- Provide parents with multiplication charts to use at home.
- Teach parents helpful strategies for fractions, place value and use of the interactive notebook during Family Math Night.
- Provide parents with Reading Comprehension Question Sheet.
- Differentiate instruction and use small groups to meet the needs of students.
- Incorporate technology to enhance student learning.
- Teach students how to use the interactive notebook.
- Model strategies and appropriate responses.
- Assess and report reading levels to at various times throughout the year.

### **Parents will**

- Attend Parent Workshops to learn strategies to help students at home.
- Practice multiplication facts with students at least 15 minutes a night.
- Help students with homework using strategies taught in class.
- Encourage students to read at home daily.
- Ask students to summarize or write a response for any reading assignment or pleasure reading they are doing.
- Review the interactive notebook with students weekly.
- Have student to use websites, interactive notebooks and Apps for additional practice.

### **Students will**

- Use strategies taught for math concepts when completing assignments, tests, and homework.
- Practice multiplication facts for at least 15 minutes each night with parents.
- Create, update and use the interactive notebook for review of strategies and concepts.
- Use reading strategies in all areas.
- Complete reading assignments in the reading interactive notebook.
- Choose “Just Right Books” to read.
- Read at home daily.
- Participate in class and ask for help when needed.

## ***What is a School-Parent Compact?***

A school-parent compact is an agreement that explains how parents, teachers and students will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. This agreement was jointly developed by stakeholders and is reviewed/ revised annually based on feedback from all stakeholders. Compacts will be discussed during parent-teacher conferences.
