### **HB251 School Transfer Option Based on Space Availability**

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The 2009 Georgia General Assembly approved House Bill 251 (HB 251), giving parents/guardians the option to request that their children attend any school within the school system *based on space availability*. School districts determine available classroom space after all assigned students have been enrolled.

In accordance with the law, the Houston County School System created a process for parents to exercise a school transfer option and process to determine space availability. Information about HB 251 is posted to the system website, <a href="www.hcbe.net">www.hcbe.net</a>, to include implementation procedures, a preliminary list of schools with available classroom space and an application to request a transfer.

Currently there are openings at 13 elementary schools: Bonaire, Centerville, Hilltop, Kings Chapel, Lindsey, Miller, Morningside, Northside, Parkwood, Russell, Shirley Hills, Tucker and Westside. <u>The openings are grade specific, as shown on page three.</u> <u>All middle schools and high schools are at capacity.</u>

Parents who desire to request a school transfer may print a "2017-2018 Application to Request Public School Transfer" from the website or pick up a form from any school. Applications for transfer will be available on-line July 1, 2017. Applications will be accepted from July 1, 2017, through August 21, 2017. Applications must be postmarked by August 21, 2017.

Applications will be approved based on the order in which they are received. Families that request a transfer will be notified of approval or denial by August 28, 2017.

Houston County bases availability on 80 percent capacity in classrooms. The preliminary list of schools that currently have available classroom space may change. The list of schools with classroom space available will be finalized based on the tenth day of school enrollment, August 15, 2017. This allows time for a more accurate enrollment number at each school based on new students and school withdrawals.

#### HB251 School Transfer Option Based on Space Availability/ Page 2 of 2

<u>All students will begin the school year at their home-zoned school</u>. Approved transfers will be effective by September 5, 2017, following notification. Parents who transfer their children under HB 251 are required by law to assume all costs and responsibilities related to the transportation of the student to and from school as long as the child remains at that school.

Applications for transfer must be mailed to the Assistant Superintendent for School Operations, Dr. Richard Rogers. The address is: Houston County Board of Education, P.O. Box 1850, Perry, Georgia, 31069. Schools are not accepting these applications.

#### HB 251 (2017-2018) - Implementation Procedures

- 1. Parents of Houston County School System students will be notified of HB251 by July 1 of each year and provided with a preliminary list of schools (with less than 80 percent capacity) based on existing data.
- 2. Parents may get an "Application to Request Public School Transfer" from their zoned school or may download a copy from <a href="https://www.hcbe.net">www.hcbe.net</a> beginning July 1.
- 3. Applications for transfer must be mailed to the Assistant Superintendent for School Operations, HCBOE, P.O. Box 1850, Perry, GA, 31069.
- 4. Applications for transfer will be available on-line July 1, 2017. <u>Applications will be accepted July 1, 2017, until August 21, 2017</u>. After the August 21 deadline, no applications will be accepted for the remainder of the school year.
- 5. All applications for transfer must be postmarked by the August 21, 2017 deadline.
- 6. Capacity will be determined by a school's enrollment on the tenth day of the school year after all assigned students have been enrolled. Schools and/or grade levels may be removed or added after this date due to student enrollment.
- 7. In the event the number of transfer requests exceeds the available capacity in the particular school, requests will be approved based on the order in which they were received.
- 8. Parents will be notified of the approval or denial of their request by August 28, 2017.
- 9. <u>All students are to begin the school year at their home zoned school</u>. Approved transfers will be effective by Tuesday, **September 5, 2017.**
- 10. Once a request is approved, the parent assumes all costs and responsibilities related to the transportation of their child to and from the school so long as the child remains at that assigned school.
