

SCHOOL BUS RULES



Follow directions of the bus driver the first time given.

Go directly to an available or assigned seat when entering the bus.

Remain seated.

Sit face forward with your back against the back of the seat.

Tell your Driver if someone is picking on you or making you feel uncomfortable.

Keep aisle and exits clear.

Use classroom conduct at all times.

Respect the rights and safety of others.

Do not destroy property.

Remain quiet enough not to distract the driver.

Remain absolutely quiet at railroad grade crossings.

No chewing gum, eating or drinking.

Do not throw objects on the bus.

Do not put your head, arms or any other object out of the bus windows.

No alcohol, drugs, or weapons.

Do not use obscene language or gestures.

Do not operate cell phones while on the bus.

Do not bring onto the bus any animals, glass objects or items too large to hold in your lap.

Help keep the bus clean.

Refrain from leaving or boarding the bus at locations other than the assigned stop.

Follow procedures to obtain signed permission for a change of stop location.
