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## ATTENTION 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Your student is currently receiving breakfast and lunch at no cost as part of the *Community Eligibility Provision*. **Your child may not be able to eat at no cost next school year.** Unless your child will attend Northside Middle School, this benefit will not follow him/her to the new middle school, and your child will not be able to eat free of charge.

However, your student may be eligible to receive free or reduced price meals regardless of their school location. To determine your child's eligibility, you must complete a 2014-2015 Free and Reduced Price Meal Application. The application will be mailed directly to you during the month of July OR **you may apply online after July 1 at [www.houston.schoollunchapp.com](http://www.houston.schoollunchapp.com).**

Upon receipt of the application, our office will determine, in accordance with federal guidelines, whether your child is eligible to receive free, reduced, or full-price meals. You will be notified of your child's meal status once the application has been processed.

If you do not complete a 2014-2015 Free and Reduced Price Meal Application, you must provide the funding necessary to feed your child beginning July 31, 2014. Middle school meal prices are \$1.50 for breakfast and \$2.50 for lunch.
