

**Huntingdon Special School District
Procedures for Resolving Protests and Disputes
As They Relate to
Federal Grants and Awards
June 2016**

Huntingdon Special School District will resolve all protests and disputes as set forth in 2 C.F.R. – Subpart A – Chapter II – Part 200 – Subpart D - §200.318

- Huntingdon Special School District will be alone be responsible, in accordance with good administrative practice and sound business judgment, for the settlement of all contractual and administrative issues arising out of procurements with any potential vendors. These issues include:
 - Source Evaluations
 - Protests
 - Disputes
 - Claims
- These standards do not relieve Huntingdon Special School District of any contractual responsibilities under its contracts, and Huntingdon Special School District will work with potential vendors to resolve any evaluations, protests, disputes, and/or claims.
- The Federal awarding agency will not substitute its judgment for that of Huntingdon Special School District unless the matter is primarily a Federal concern.
- Any and/or all violations of law will be referred to the local, state, or Federal authority having proper jurisdiction.
