

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
FEBRUARY 13, 2007

The Jefferson County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, February 13, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. Members present were: Chairman James E. Fleming, Jr., Mr. Charlie Brown, Mr. Steve Norton, Mr. Bobby Butts, Mrs. Georgia Hunter, Superintendent Carl Bethune and Board Attorney J. Franklin Edenfield.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Fleming and Mr. Fleming led the invocation.

On motion by Mr. Brown, second by Mr. Norton, the board unanimously approved the agenda with a change to move Item 5 (Mr. Cleveland) ahead of Item 4 (Financial Report).

On motion by Mr. Butts, second by Mrs. Hunter, the board unanimously approved the following consent agenda items:

John Cleveland, GEMA Consultant, presented certificates to Mr. Bethune and all principals for approval of the Jefferson County Emergency Operations Safety Plan. He recognized Dr. Hodges for her work in getting the plan written. He recognized Mr. Lamar Baxley, local EMA Director, for his support of safety in the schools.

The January Financial Report was presented and reviewed by Mr. Bethune. On motion by Mr. Norton, second by Mr. Brown, the board unanimously approved the January 2007 Financial Report.

A discussion was held about the need for sports lights at Wrens Middle School. On motion by Mr. Norton, second by Mrs. Brown, the board unanimously approved a proposal from Otis Tree and Lighting to remove 3 clusters of lights from the Wrens Middle School Football field for \$1,500 and to install 16 – 1500 watt sports lights for \$350 per fixture (\$5,600 total cost).

The E-rate bids for telecommunications internal connections, and internet services were opened on February 1, 2007. These bids cover services from July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008. Cindy Rabun presented an overview of the E-rate proposal for FY08. On motion by Mrs. Hunter, second by Mr. Butts, the board unanimously approved the proposal as presented.

Thomas McCall from Louisville Middle School was recognized as Custodian of the Month. Sam Dasher was on hand to help with the recognition. Mr. McCall was given a day off with pay.

Lynette Brooks from Wrens Elementary was recognized as Support Person of the Month. Sharon Dye was on hand to help with the recognition. Mrs. Brooks will be given a day off with pay.

Sam Dasher, principal of Louisville Middle School, assisted Dr. Hodges with the Testgate presentation. (Julia Wells, principal of Wrens Middle School, who was scheduled to be on the agenda, was unable to attend because of extended jury duty service.) Mr. Dasher gave an overview of how Louisville Middle School uses Testgate data in planning instruction.

The implementation of school improvements plans was discussed by Dr. Hodges. She gave an overview of how the SIPs are regularly reviewed through the principal evaluation process.

Dr. Donnie Hodges discussed taking more time and going over Policy Section G (Personnel) after staff has time to do more research in order to make more informed decisions. More recommendations for the 'G' policy section will be forthcoming in March.
