English Language Arts

For 2017-2018 in grades 3-11 in Literacy on the TN Ready Assessment, our District TVAAS Composite score will be at a level 3 or higher.

Math

For 2017-2018 in grades 3-11 in Numeracy on the TN Ready Assessment, our District TVAAS Composite score will be at a level 3 or higher.

Safe and Healthy Schools

For 2017-2018, students will have equal access to a safe learning environment that promotes academic achievement, limits the amount of lost instructional time, and ensures that all students have the opportunity to learn as evidenced by the reduction of student disciplinary actions, expulsions, and attendance and chronic absenteeism rates.

Kindergarten Readiness

For 2017-2018, students entering kindergarten will have the cognitive, language and literacy, social and emotional and physical skills necessary to effectively transition to kindergarten and meet early literacy milestones as evidenced through the Kindergarten screenings.

College and Career Ready Students

For 2017-2018, the district will maintain or improve the graduation rate of 91%.
