Course Description (*Portfolio Review Required*) Visual Arts AP is designed to allow the serious art student who wishes to pursue post-secondary work in the visual arts an opportunity to prepare an exit level portfolio that meets AP standards. Activities will include refinement of work, digital imaging of work, matting, mounting and AP exam preparation. Portfolio development will follow the College Board Advanced Placement course description. Students may complete the portfolio in Drawing or 2D Design. Students will take the AP Studio Exam in May. A fee for the materials will be charged.
