I. Standards & Objectives

First Nine Weeks

Unit I- Using **avoir, être** and **-ER, -IR, -RE** verbs and adjectives:

- I can describe myself and others and ask about others.
- I can talk about likes and dislikes.
- I can inquire.
- I can tell when I do something.

Unit II- Using direct and indirect object pronouns and the **passé composé**:

- I can wish someone a good time.
- I can ask for and give advice.
- I can ask for help.
- I can check and see if things have been done.

Unit III- Using the partitive, question formation and the pronoun **en**:

- I can ask about food preparation.
- I can make requests.
- I can shop for groceries.
- I can ask where things are.

Second Nine Weeks

Unit IV- Using object pronouns with the **passé composé** and the verbs **recevoir** and **suivre**:

- I can ask how something turned out.
- I can wonder what happened.
- I can ask for information.
- I can express frustration.

Unit V- Using reflexive verbs:

- I can talk about my routine.
- I can express impatience.
- I can say when I do things.
- I can make recommendations.

Unit VI- Using the **passé composé** and the **imparfait**:

- I can talk about what I did when I was a child.
- I can tell about an event in the past.
- I can compare life in the country to life in the city.
- I can describe life in the country.
