Unit I

Unit IV

Using verbs that have -g in the Yo form of the present tense and the present progressive:

- I can tell what I do at the airport
- I can talk about being on an airplane
- I can discuss air travel in South America

Unit V

Using reflexive verbs and commands with FAVOR DE:

- I can identify more parts of the body
- I can talk about my daily routine
- I can talk about backpacking and camping

Unit VI

Using the preterit of irregular verbs and the present and preterit of DECIR with prepositional pronouns:

- I can use vocabulary related to train travel
- I can discuss interesting train trips in Perú and México

Using stem-changing verbs in the present and preterit and the passive voice with SE:
