What Does the Levy Fund?



Requested Rate of Tax	Cost Per \$1,000 Assessed
2016 Approved	Projected \$2.29
2017 Levy request	Projected \$2.28
2018 Levy request	Projected \$2.28





Why Does the School District Need to Have a Levy?

Washington state only funds approximately 82% of the cost of operating schools. This "M&O" levy supplements the remaining 18% of the district's budget. The School Board chooses to go to the voters every two years to renew its levy. The current levy (2015/2016) expires at the end of this year and was voted on in February 2014. In that round, 59.91% of voters responded that YES, they support our local school district. This proposed levy (2017/18) will renew local support and allow the district to continue operating without interruption.
