Head Over Teal is a family friendly event consisting of a 5k Run that begins at 8 a.m. and a 1 mile fun walk immediately following. The event will also include fun activities for all ages, including children's inflatable games, face painting, crafts, and more. There is no reliable early detection test for ovarian cancer. If it is caught early, it can be successfully treated in 90+% of the cases. However, most patients are diagnosed in the later stages when the disease is more difficult to treat. The Laura Crandall Brown Ovarian Cancer Foundation was established in 2010 by family and friends of Laura Crandall Brown who died of ovarian cancer in December of 2009. Our mission is to fund research to find a reliable diagnostic tool to detect ovarian cancer in its earliest stages and to raise awareness about the signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer.
