RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Lawrence Union Free School District No. 15, Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York be authorized to transfer up to Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) of unexpended, unreserved funds to the Capital Reserve Fund to pay costs of the construction, reconstruction, renovation and equipping of School District buildings and other facilities during the 2018-2019 school year, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings and other improvements in connection therewith, which improvements include: Lawrence High School and Broadway Campus Sports and Athletics Facilities Renovations and Replacement, Broadway Campus HVAC, Broadway Campus Bathroom Renovations, Broadway Campus Hallways and Vestibule Renovations, Broadway Campus Interior Upgrades and Renovations, Broadway Campus Auditorium renovations, Broadway Campus Electrical Upgrades and Improvements, Lawrence High School Locker Replacements, District Wide Security Renovations, District Wide Roof Replacements, District Wide Lighting and Ceiling Replacements, District Wide Site Improvements and other improvements and costs incidental thereto.
