

Siler & Ingber Opioid Awareness Scholarship

More people died from an opioid overdose in Nassau and Suffolk counties in 2017 than ever before, contributing to the Nationwide opioid epidemic. The attorneys at Siler & Ingber, LLP, have partnered with the Rabinowitz Family Foundation to offer a scholarship to a student who has been affected by the opioid crisis.

In order to apply for the \$5,000 educational scholarship available to high school seniors and college students, applicants will be asked to write an essay describing how the opioid epidemic has made an impact on their lives and how they plan to use their education to fight the epidemic. The scholarship serves two important purposes: 1) to raise awareness of the opioid epidemic and inspire others to make a difference, and 2) to empower those who have been impacted to produce real change in the world.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Recipient is accepted, and will be attending a two or four year university or trade school in the fall of 2018
- Academic achievement as reflected by an undergraduate or high school cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA
- Applicant must be a resident of New York State

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must submit the following by May 31, 2019:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- One to three (1-3) page typed essay
- An official and complete copy of high school or most recent college transcripts
- An acceptance letter from an accredited University or Trade School
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (i.e., birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)

AWARD:

- Siler & Ingber Scholarship is to be used exclusively for tuition or class fees.
- A check for \$5,000 will be made payable to the award recipient's University to cover tuition.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.

DEADLINE: Completed applications must be submitted via email in PDF form (giving@nylawnet.com) no later than May 31, 2019.
