

## 2019-2020 Senior Late Arrival Guidelines and Permission Form

This year Liberty High School is giving certain seniors the ability to arrive after 1st hour. There are some rules and guidelines that any senior wishing to participate in early release must agree to and abide by.

1. Students arriving late must be enrolled in seven credit earning classes.
2. Students must maintain a grade of a C or greater in all classes (as determined each Monday when Mrs. Badgley runs the ineligibility reports) **If a student has a grade lower than a C when the ineligibility report is ran, they will be expected to remain in study hall 8th hour until that grade is at a C or higher.**
3. Students who have had disciplinary actions by the administration or teachers will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
4. Students who have attendance issues will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
5. Students who leave after seventh hour must leave the building and parking lot, any students found to be loitering on school grounds will have their early release privileges revoked.
6. **There will be no early release on 11:30 days, as well as special days such as can out day and homecoming decoration day.**

It is important to remember that early release is a privilege, not a right. At any time the administration may decided to revoke your privilege or stop all early releases for any reason. If either of these situations happen then you will be expected to report to your 8th hour study hall as normal.
