Superintendent's Comments:

Increased Rates of Pay

The Liberty School Board had to take a hard look at our sub situation regarding para educators, who essentially keep the class going when no sub teacher is available and for nurses who are willing to sub in a school during this crazy COVID time. Effort was made to increase the rates for the additional responsibilities they are taking on. We also made a change at how to handle sub teacher rate of pay for teachers who take on multiple, long-term (6 weeks or more) maternity or medical leaves. Hopefully, this will allow us to have quality individuals willing to helps us when we are short on essential staff.

Esports

This year our new computer teacher, Tyler Eveland, was approved to pilot an esports club. This has become a very popular activity for students. Some colleges are offering scholarships for esports.
