Superintendent's Comments:

<u>Audit</u>

This year the audit was a little bit delayed. However, we are excited that our financial profile remains excellent; being a 4.0 out of 4.0. This shows how hard the school board is working to be fiscally responsible. I hope tax payers of the Liberty Community will be grateful for the school board's efforts. One value that is always shared during the audit is the cost to educate a student at Liberty School. That cost is \$7,949, which is what we would charge for out-of-district tuition.

Tax Levy

The Liberty School Board chose to keep the same tax rate as they have for several years. So, the only areas to adjust are Social Security, Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, and Tort (which is safety items and services). We hope this is welcomed news to the tax payers. However, the value of land has gone up, so an increase in the equalized assessed value will be noticed by community members. It appears that this is going up around 7.7%. We have to keep the other funds of the tax levy at the maximum amount because we need it to operate the school effectively.

Bass Fishing Club

This group of sponsors who volunteer their time for the Bass Fishing Club do a phenomenal job! The school board wanted to help by covering the cost of gas for the vehicles who haul the boats and the gas to run the boats. The school board took action to support this. We have several students who participate in this club. Keep up the great work Fessler Family!!!

Memorandum of Agreement

The school board took action with the teacher's union and the PERA Joint Committee not to include student growth in this year's teacher evaluation, as approved by ISBE. We are still evaluating and still monitoring student performance. Yet, this score is not included in the overall summative rate for the evaluation. It makes sense not to do this during a pandemic, which is going on year three. Teachers were elated to be relieved of this stress!
