

LIMESTONE COUNTY BOARD of EDUCATION
Board Meeting

February 24, 2014 at 6:00 p.m.

- A. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. Notices for the meeting were properly posted and provided to those who requested direct notification.**
- B. Those Board members present were Mr. Marty Adams, Mr. Earl Glaze, Mr. Anthony Hilliard, Mr. Bret McGill, Mr. Darin Russell, Mr. James Shannon, and Mr. Charles Shoulders. Superintendent Dr. Tom Sisk was present.**
- C. Mr. Glaze led everyone in prayer.**
- D. Mr. Adams led everyone in reciting the pledge of allegiance.**

AGENDA

1. Approve Agenda

Mr. Adams asked if there were any additions to the agenda. Dr. Sisk asked that the following item be added to the agenda:

3. Discussion/Approval – School Ban for Mr. Mickey Glass

Dr. Sisk recommended the Board approve the agenda. Mr. Glaze made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Mr. Adams. The vote was unanimous.

2. Personnel Action Item

- A. Mickey Glass resigned his employment with the Limestone County Board of Education effective February 24, 2014.**

Mr. Glaze made a motion to accept the resignation of Mr. Mickey Glass, and Mr. Adams seconded. Mr. Adams called for discussion.

Board members asked if Mr. Glass would be entitled to retirement benefits. Mr. Glaze commented that he did not like the fact that an employee who stole thousands of dollars from the schools is reaping benefits from it. Dr. Sisk agreed. Ms. Zebbra Green noted that Mr. Glass's teaching certificate would be pulled. Board members asked what benefits Mr. Glass would be entitled to after his resignation. Ms. Green answered that the state will make the decision.

The Board then asked if Mr. Glass would be able to purchase COBRA. Ms. Ann Swanner said that he would be unable to do so through Limestone County Schools. Mr. McGill asked if the school system can notify the retirement system. Ms. Green said her department would be notifying the state department of education and would check into notifying the retirement

system.

Mr. Glaze then commented that Mr. Glass was stealing not only from the Career Technical Center as well as Elkmont High School. Dr. Sisk said administrators are held to a higher standard and that the system had gone to great lengths to get an account of what is missing. Mr. Glaze read a news release to the Board and audience regarding the situation. Other Board members expressed their disappointment with the situation.

A vote was taken. The vote was unanimous to accept the resignation of Mr. Mickey Glass.

3. Discussion/Approval – School Ban

Mr. Glaze made a motion to approve the superintendent's recommendation to ban Mr. Mickey Glass from Limestone County School property, and Mr. Adams seconded. Under discussion, Mr. Glaze asked Dr. Sisk if it was his intention to ban Mr. Glass for life. Dr. Sisk replied that it was his intention that the ban be for life. Mr. Glaze amended his motion to ban Mr. Mickey Glass for life from Limestone County Schools property, and Mr. McGill seconded. After discussing the fact that Mr. Glass has children in the system, a vote was taken. Those in favor were: Mr. Adams, Mr. Glaze, Mr. Hilliard, Mr. McGill, Mr. Russell, and Mr. Shannon. Mr. Shoulders was opposed.

4. There were no further comments from the Board.

5. The meeting was adjourned at 6:23 p.m.
