How Were High School Scores Calculated?

1. **Academic Achievement (20%)**: based on ACT Aspire tests in 6th - 8th & 10th grade. Aspire no longer used as state assessment because questions did not meet State CCRS standards.
2. **Academic Growth (30%)**: based on progress from previous year. Growth categories include Low, Average, and High in Grades 6th - 8th & 10th grade.
3. **Graduation Rate (30%)**: based on 2015 - 2016 cohort.
4. **College & Career Readiness (10%)**: must meet 1 of 6 CCRS indicators
5. **Chronic Absenteeism (10%)**: percent who missed 15 days (excused or unexcused).

2. **Academic Growth (50%)**: based on progress from previous year. Growth categories include Low, Average, and High in Grades 3rd - 5th grade.
3. **Chronic Absenteeism (10%)**: percent who missed 15 days (excused or unexcused).
