

The Benton County R-2 School District board members continued the meeting in executive session on June 19, 2017 beginning at 8:05 P.M. Board members present were Mehrens, Kroenke, Beaman, Parrott, Yearout, and Eichler. Ebeling was absent.

Kevin Smith, Marc Spunaugle, Becky Eifert, Michelle Smith, and Carol Waibel were also present.

A motion was made by Beaman, seconded by Parrott to employ Larry Huffman as the part-time Spanish teacher for the 2017-2018 School year. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Yearout-yes; Eichler-yes; Ebeling-absent; Parrott-yes; Beaman-yes; Kroenke-yes; and Mehrens-yes. Motion carried 6 yes, 0 no.

Mr. Smith shared that Scott Calhoun did not accept the contract offer for the Business teaching position.

Mr. Spunaugle interviewed Kelly Robey for the Business position last week. She is also interested in the Junior High Volleyball coaching position, the FBLA sponsor, and an assistant softball coaching position.

A motion was made by Beaman, seconded by Parrott to employ Lane Johnson as an assistant Junior High Football coach (\$500 stipend) for the 2017-2018 school year. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Yearout-yes; Eichler-yes; Ebeling-absent; Parrott-yes; Beaman-yes; Kroenke-yes; and Mehrens-yes. Motion carried 6 yes, 0 no.

A motion was made by Kroenke, seconded by Yearout to employ Ryan Spry as an Assistant HS Football coach (\$500 stipend) for the 2017-2018 school year. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Yearout-yes; Eichler-yes; Ebeling-absent; Parrott-yes; Beaman-yes; Kroenke-yes; and Mehrens-yes. Motion carried 6 yes, 0 no.

There being no further business for executive session a motion was made by Yearout, seconded by Eichler to adjourn the executive session at 8:25 P.M.
