THE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM EVALUATION WILL BE REVIEWED BY THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD IN THE SPRING OF EACH YEAR TO KEEP THEM APPRISED OF THE PROGRAM. THE TECHNOLOGY PLAN WILL BE DISSEMINATED TO ALL STAKEHOLDERS. PRINTED COPIES WILL BE AVAILABLE IN EACH ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE, EACH SCHOOL LIBRARY, AND COPIES WILL BE PROVIDED ON REQUEST. THE TECHNOLOGY PLAN WILL BE AVAILABLE IN A PRINTABLE FORMAT ON THE DISTRICT'S WEB PAGE. INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED TO LOCAL NEWSPAPERS AND RADIO STATIONS TO KEEP THE COMMUNITY ABREAST OF HAPPENINGS WITHIN THE DISTRICT. INFORMATION ON POLICIES, PROGRAMS AND EVENTS RELATED TO TECHNOLOGY WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED THROUGH DAILY AND WEEKLY BULLETINS. THESE ITEMS WILL ALSO BE MAINTAINED ON THE DISTRICT'S WEB PAGE.



The Universal Service Fund E-rate Program states that district long-range plans must address five essential elements. The district provides assurances to DESE that the technology plan contains the following:

- Clear goals and realistic strategies for using telecommunications and information technology to improve education services;
- Professional development strategies to ensure that staff know to use these new technologies to improve education services;
- Sufficient budget to acquire and support the non-discounted elements of the plan:
- the hardware, software, professional development and other services that will be needed to implement the strategy; and
- Evaluation process that enables the school to monitor progress toward the specified goals and make mid-course corrections in response to new developments and opportunities as they arise.
