11	4	Explain causes of and major events occurring during the War of 1812 <i>Examples: causes – impressments, territorial disputes; events – burning of Washington, D. C.; creation of War Hawks; composition of the “Star-Spangled Banner;” Battle of Horseshoe Bend; Battle of New Orleans</i>		
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Locate on a map, major areas of conflict in the War of 1812, including Washington, D. C. 		
12	4	Identify causes of the Civil War from the northern and southern viewpoints <i>Examples: states’ rights, slave versus free states</i>		
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the importance of the Missouri Compromise, the Compromise of 1850, John Brown’s Rebellion, and the Emancipation Proclamation 		
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the impact of the Civil War on the social, economic, and political life of the United States Identify on a map, locations important to the Civil War <i>Examples: Mason-Dixon Line, Fort Sumter, Appomattox, Confederate states, Union states, Confederate capitals</i> 		
13	4	Identify social, political, and economic changes that occurred during Reconstruction		
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the effects of Reconstruction on women and African Americans <i>Examples: voting rights for African-American males, women as heads of households, stabilization of the African-American family, role of self-help and mutual aid</i>
