## **Frequently Asked Questions about the *Evening Educational Options Program (EEOP)***

### **Who can attend EEOP?**

Students can attend EEOP through a referral from their current Mobile County Public high school. EEOP serves students in grades 9-12, but priority placement is given to seniors who are at risk of not graduating.

### **How are students placed in EEOP?**

Teachers, guidance counselors and administrators at a student's current Mobile County Public high school collaborate to determine whether a referral to EEOP should be completed.

### **Where is EEOP located?**

EEOP is located at Pillans Middle School, 2051 Military Rd., Mobile, AL 36605.

### **When are classes held?**

Classes are held in the evening.
