

## OFFER VERSUS SERVE

Students in grades K-8 shall not be required to take the entire meal that is served under the National School Lunch/Breakfast programs.

Schools will offer the entire lunch, five (5) components, but students in grades K-8 will be able to refuse two(2) of those which they do not intend to eat, but children must select at least ½ cut of fruit or vegetable of the remaining three(3).

Students shall be encouraged to take all five (5) components.

Schools will offer 4 components for breakfast, but students will be able to refuse one (1) food component. Children must select at least ½ cup of fruit or vegetables to have a reimbursement meal. Students shall be encouraged to take all four (4) food components.

The price for each meal shall remain the same, without regard to the number of food components selected. Pre-K students meals will be pre-plated.

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
