Report of Board Committees

Building Committee – Chairman Sam Martin briefly reviewed the minutes and reported that much of the meeting was spent discussing construction issues. There will be a big move scheduled in the spring at the Middle School. John DePoister and his staff were recognized for their outstanding snow removal efforts recently.

Finance Committee — Finance Director Kathy Meyer reported that information regarding the RFP for computers was discussed. The proposal is for 200 new classroom computers and the refresh of 102 computers. The bus lease came in at a good price for 2007-2008. The Appraisal/Asset tracking proposals from three different companies were reviewed. Middle School sports officials pay was discussed and recommended to increase.

The computer purchases were also discussed (a recommendation will be made later in the meeting). The Technology Department will be hiring three experienced technology interns for the summer.
