**Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Committee** – Curriculum Director, Cathy Creek, reported that the committee met on Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. The High School PARCC testing will be completed week of May 25<sup>th</sup> and the staff and students are preparing for finals.. The Middle School and Elementary School PARCC testing went extremely smooth. The next step in the PARCC testing process will be getting our scores back which could take a while to receive (October/November). Ms. Creek reported that she attended an NCLB workshop in Alsip, IL that was put on by ISBE where she learned that the accountability practice will be different now that the AYP is no longer a factor. It is very different, with a lot of unknowns. Ms. Creek shared with the Administration on what she learned.
