

**1.0 INTRODUCTION**

Western Technologies, Inc. (WT) representative Vicky Aviles, AHERA-Accredited Inspector/Management Planner conducted an initial site visit of Butterfield Elementary School for the Maricopa Unified School District in November 2012, and the update August 6, 2015. The visit consisted of driving around the site to identify structures currently located on the campus. This document is the initial Management Plan as required by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR Part 763, for this campus.

The current structure at Butterfield Elementary School was constructed in 2008. The District was able to acquire a signed acknowledgement from the general contractor (DL Withers) and their subcontractor (Norcon) that no asbestos containing materials were used in the construction of this structure. Prior to the physical site inspection, historical aerial photographs were reviewed by the inspector to verify the land was vacant prior to the construction of this campus. Current aerial photographs were reviewed by the inspector prior to the re-inspection.

**2.0 SUMMARY OF BUILDINGS AT THIS CAMPUS**

The following was observed and documented for this site.

**2.1 Main Building**

The main building was determined to have been constructed in 2008 as indicated by Norcon Industries, subcontractor to DL Withers' affidavit of non-use of asbestos during construction dated April 2008. In this document the school was referenced as the Villages ES (Butterfield ES @ The Villages) project. This document satisfies the AHERA regulations 763.99 Exclusions: stating that no asbestos inspection is required if the acknowledgement is included in a Management Plan prepared by an EPA accredited management planner. No other structures were observed at this campus and no changes were observed at this campus during the re-inspection.



### 3.0 CONCLUSION

This Management Plan is to be maintained by the District and used in conjunction with any other future reports that address asbestos for this campus. The District is required to release a notification of the existence and location of this Management Plan to parents, teacher groups, vendors, and others that may access this campus. Copy of the notification and written description of method of distribution shall be included with this Management Plan and shall be done annually hereafter.

The Management Plan must be revised if new structures are build on this campus or if structures are demolished and/or otherwise removed from this campus. As a public document, a copy of this Management Plan must be available at the schools' main office for review by anyone upon request and a copy should be maintained by the designated person. It should be noted that other EPA and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) regulations covering asbestos and asbestos exposure and staff training also applies to this campus.

**Exterior building materials are not a part of an AHERA inspection. Suspect ACM's need to be tested and verified prior to renovation and/or demolition of a building in compliance with the OSHA and the EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) regulations as mandated by Pinal County Air Quality. This regulation is for all public and commercial structures regardless of the age of construction.**

The District is also required by AHERA to have a person designated to oversee this Management Plan and all other AHERA duties on behalf of the local education authority (LEA) known as the Maricopa Unified School District No. 20. Acceptance, by indication of signature and date, must be made by the Designated Person and that document must be apart of this Management Plan to complete the requirements of the AHERA regulations (40 CFR Part 763.93 (v) (4).

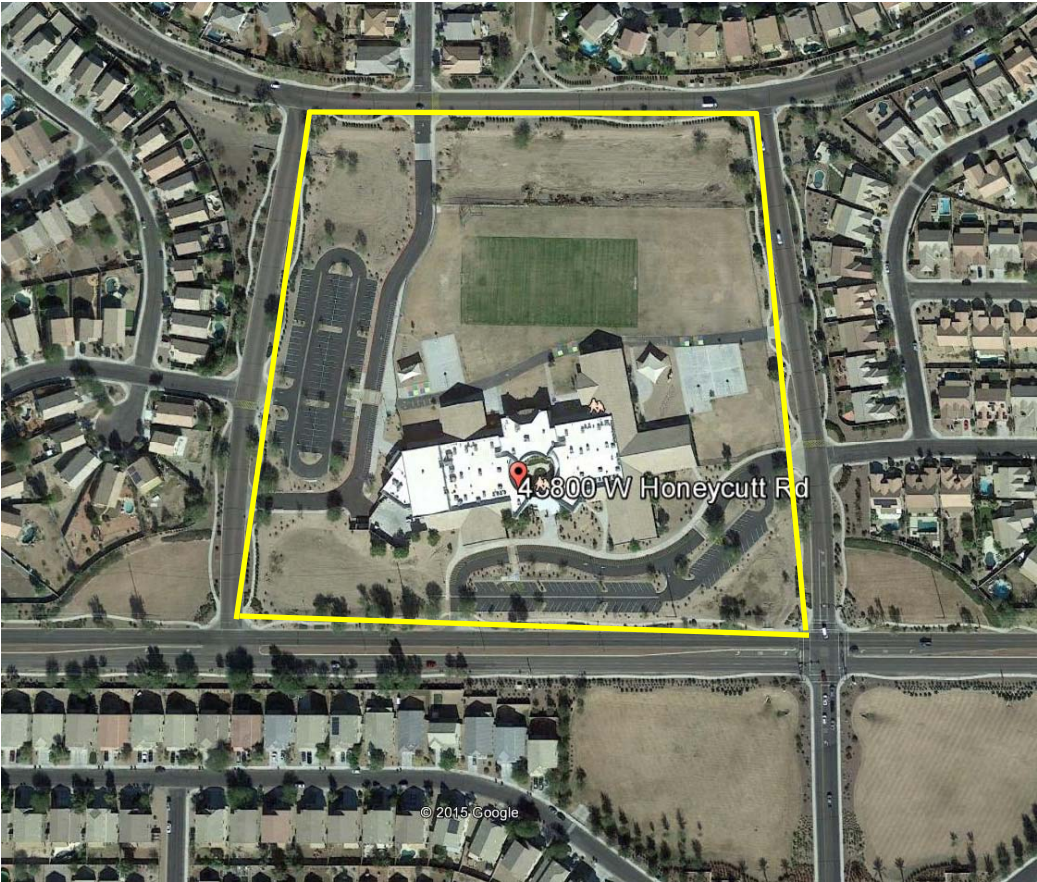

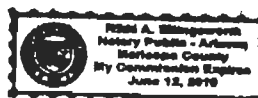
