OPENING

Call to Order

President Coutré called a meeting of the Maricopa Unified School District No. 20 Governing Board to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Board Room at the District Office Administration Building.

Dr. Miller led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Adoption of Agenda

Mrs. Anderson motioned to approve the agenda. Dr. Miller seconded. Motion passed 5/0.

Call to the Public

Mr. Joshua Judd addressed the Board regarding the override campaign. Mr. Judd presented the apples for the override campaign donation jars that will be displayed at local businesses. Mr. Judd spoke about the Override Committee's commitment to the campaign. The override committee holds meetings every Thursday (since January 2016) to develop the best plan to reach out to the community and provide information on the override. Mr. Judd explained the committee has held kick-off events, is maintaining a Facebook page and website to answer questions, and is offering t-shirts, signs, and car stickers to promote the override.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Chestnut reported that the all staff welcome back meeting took place on August 5th, where he presented a review of the 2015-16 school year, preview of 2016-17 school year, and the results of the spring 2016 PSAT tests where Maricopa High School 10th and 11th graders who took the test scored higher than the state and national average. Dr. Chestnut reminded the staff of the 2016-17 override election on November 8th and that the 2016-17 National Board Professional Development Schools are Maricopa High School, Maricopa Elementary School and Butterfield Elementary School. Mr. Jeff Kramarczyk from the Maricopa Education Foundation presented at the welcome back meeting and reminded all the staff about the grant money available to them during the school year. Dr. Chestnut spoke about Mr. Joe Thomas, the Arizona Education Association Presidents presentation at the welcome back meeting. Dr. Chestnut announced that for 2016-17 school year Butterfield Elementary School, Pima Butte Elementary School, and Santa Cruz Elementary School will be participating in the Positive Behavior Intervention and Support professional development as part of a grant awarded from Arizona Department of Education. Dr. Chestnut said the Arizona Department of Education also sponsored the EDISA training that will be taking place at Maricopa Elementary School, Saddleback Elementary School and Santa Rosa Elementary School.

Dr. Chestnut reported that the current MUSD certified opening is for one MHS ESS teacher and on the 1st day of school 98.5% of MUSD certified opening was filled.

Dr. Chestnut said August 8th was the 1st day of school and it was a good start. On August 10th the enrollment totals were 3,361 elementary students, 3,100 secondary schools with a total of 6,461 district wide.

Dr. Chestnut spoke about the blended learning expansions at Desert Wind Middle School, Maricopa Wells Middle School and Santa Rosa Elementary School along with the relocation of the Maricopa Wells Middle School library. Dr. Chestnut also talked about the updates to Maricopa Wells Middle Schools landscaping in front of the administration office; Desert Wind Middle School courtyard; and Maricopa High School office entry to provide security into the campus. Dr. Chestnut announced the Maricopa High School low adventure course has been installed on the campus.

Dr. Chestnut reported that he will be presenting his MUSD annual report to the Maricopa Chamber of Commerce on August 11th. Dr. Chestnut announced that on August 16th ABC15 will be at Maricopa Wells Middle School and Santa Rosa Elementary School blended learning classrooms to shoot a segment for Sonoran Living Live which is scheduled to be aired on August 23rd. Both Dr. Chestnut and Mayor Christian Price will be interviewed.

Dr. Chestnut congratulated Mr. Aron Rausch and the Business Office staff for winning the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for 9 consecutive years.

Mrs. Melvin attended the welcome back meeting on August 5th and enjoyed Mr. Thomas' presentation. Mrs. Melvin expressed her excitement for the beginning of the school year and will be attending the Arizona School Board Association Black Caucus meeting on August 12th.

Dr. Miller thanked the Business Department for the work they are doing and congratulated them for winning the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting. Dr. Miller will be attending the Maricopa Chamber of Commerce on August 11th.

Mrs. Knorr is excited to begin touring the school sites in a few weeks and said all district staff was amazing with the beginning of the school year.
