Tentative Classroom Assignment Plan for 2018-19

Dr. Chestnut presented the tentative classroom assignment plan for 2018-19. Dr. Chestnut said the projection is to hire 15 new teachers and 1.5 new ESS teacher. Dr. Chestnut said as of right now 6 teachers are not returning.

The Board is concerned about the expected growth that the District will be going through in the near future and how space will be an issue at the High School. The Board requested that after spring break an agenda item be added to one of the board meetings for Mr. Rausch to report on property status, timelines, and costs for the potential of building a second high school.

Review monthly financial report for January 2018

Mr. Rausch presented the Monthly Financial Report for January 2018. For the month of January M & O fund has a budget of \$41,661,710 and current expenditures of \$2,931,845. Currently M & O encumbrances are \$18,631,907. Projected fund balance of \$1,729,137 before all entered Encumbrances, Journal Entries for all of our transfers to other Funds and Final Grant Transfers, 85% of our budgets are salary related. District Additional Assistance Fund 610 (formerly Unrestricted Capital Fund and 625 Soft Capital Funds), our budget is \$2,432,063 with \$164,406 spent and a Projected Fund Balance of \$403,946. The class site funds have a budget of \$2,963,374. The Student Activities Report shows a beginning monthly balance of \$159,061, receipts of \$12,627, disbursements of \$17,266, and an ending monthly balance of \$154,422.
