## M&O Override Update

Mr. Aron Rausch reported that in the 2017-18 M&O override pamphlet language it called for 50 teachers and \$500,000 technology expenditures. The FY 2017/18 M&O override actual revenue is \$3,453,173 and the FY 2018/19 projected revenue is \$3,842,000. The FY 2017/18 M&O override expenditures is 49 teacher salaries and 1 staff overload (teacher salary), 695 computers/19 carts/100 doc cams which total \$378,000. Also included are 2 tech staff and portion of tech director/engineer salaries totaling \$134,000. The FY 2018/19 M&O override expenditures is 50 teacher salaries, 792 computers/14 carts totaling \$223,000, 4 tech staff and portion of tech director/engineer salaries totaling \$226,200 and still to be budgeted is \$75,500.

Ms. Coutré requested that this presentation be put on the district website. Mrs. Anderson requested a follow-up report regarding the technology currently supporting the extra computers and what is needed to sustain them with the proper bandwidth and Wi-Fi capabilities. Ms. Coutré agreed with Mrs. Anderson regarding a technology inventory report that would show what we have and where we need to be. Dr. Lopeman said Mrs. Roden and Mr. Kartchner are working on applying the same strategies and same processes as with the district strategic plan to a technology strategic plan and it should be completed in the next few weeks.
