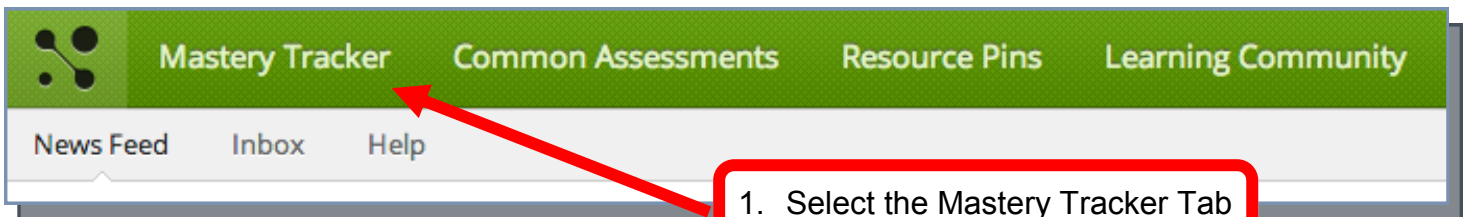
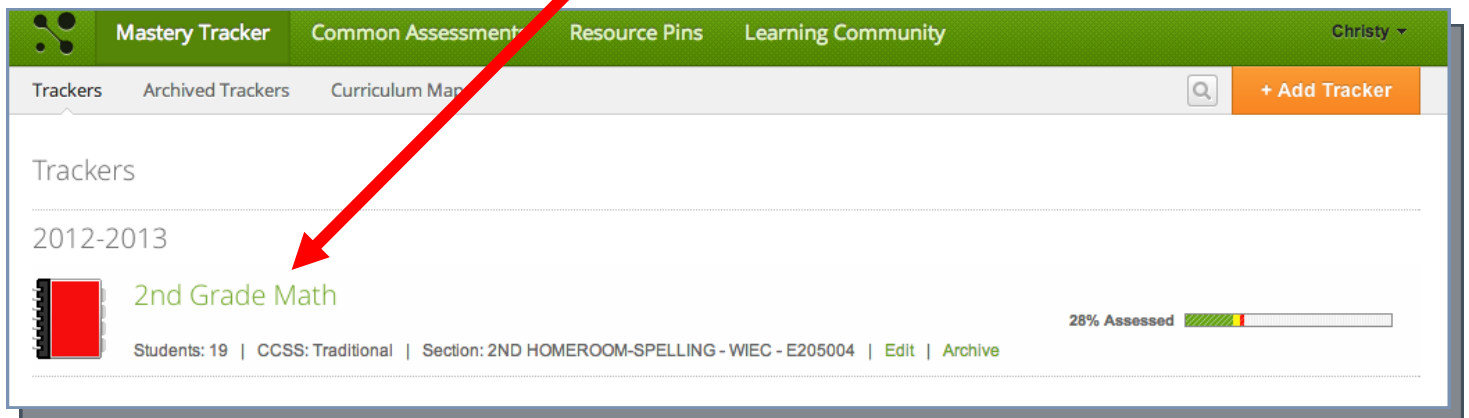


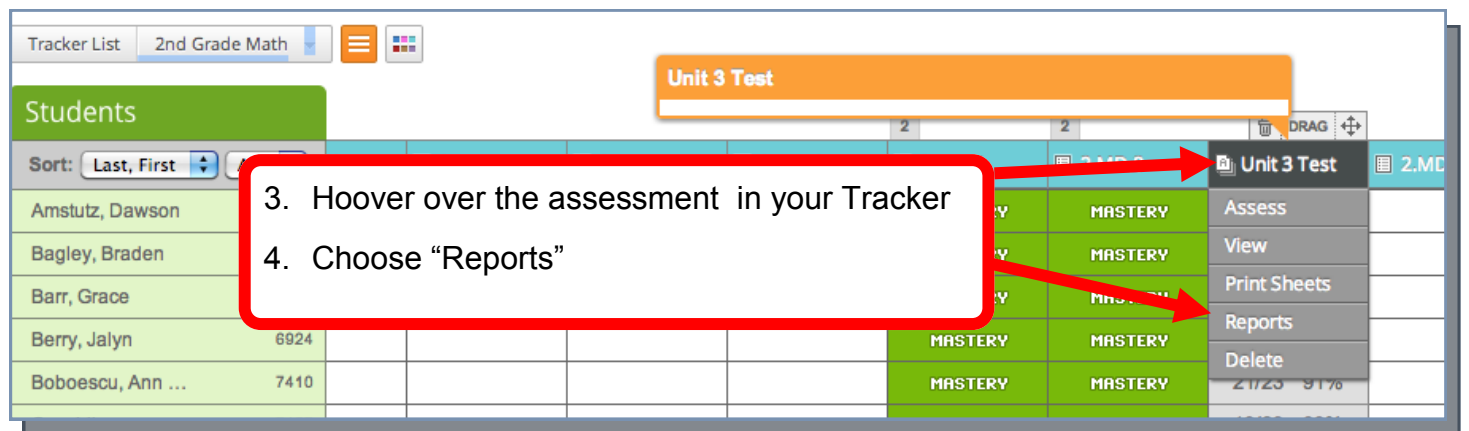
# MasteryConnect: Using Reports to Analyze Data

### Student Detail View

From the Student view you can do the following:

- Mouse over a standard to view the short description and click on that standard
- Quickly view current mastery status as well as the history of how a student has performed at each assessment instance.
- View the actual assessment given (provided the teacher makes it available), as well as the answer key, the answers that student gave, and how that compared to the rest of the class.
- View reports relative to that student by clicking on the orange menu button and selecting “Reports”. Notice a current mastery report as well as a progress timeline.
- Email parents a link to their student’s interactive report.

In addition, from the orange menu button you may also add anecdotal student notes and parent notes.
