1 The Board is charged, on behalf of the public, with the responsibility for determining the educational goals
2 of the school system. In discharging that responsibility, the Board has adopted the following goals in four
3 primary areas: Instruction, personnel, students and operations.
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5 The Board shall develop policies to implement the goals within each area and shall annually review these
6 goals and revise them as necessary so that each program will at all times support the stated goals.
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8 **INSTRUCTION**

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- 10 1. To promote a plan for the organized improvement of school curriculum, including the articulation
11 between elementary and secondary schools;
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 - 13 2. To provide offerings which explore a wide range of career and service opportunities;
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 - 15 3. To promote an integration of academic, physical, social and emotional growth experiences for each
16 student; and
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 - 18 4. To promote the recognition of achievement in all endeavors (example, academic, athletic).
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20 **STUDENTS**

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- 22 1. To structure the overall instructional program to provide sufficient alternatives to meet a variety
23 of individual needs and aspirations;
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 - 25 2. To ensure that each student's interests, capacities and objectives are considered in his/her learning
26 program;
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 - 28 3. To develop a comprehensive program for disabled students providing the least restrictive pro-
29 grams; and
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 - 31 4. To help students gain understanding of themselves, as well as skills and techniques in living and
32 working with others and being responsible citizens.
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34 **PERSONNEL**

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- 36 1. To provide high quality performance by the staff, including both professional and support person-
37 nel;
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 - 39 2. To establish acceptable performance standards for all personnel;
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- 1 3. To provide in-service training and professional growth experiences for teachers and administra-
2 tors; and
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- 4 4. To maintain an evaluation system for the improvement of the instructional system.
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6 **OPERATIONS**

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- 8 1. To make every effort to secure adequate funding for the educational program in support of the
9 stated goals;
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- 11 2. To maintain an adequate system of fiscal and business management;
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- 13 3. To develop plans for the efficient use of school facilities; and
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- 15 4. To ensure appropriate communication between the director of schools and the Board.
