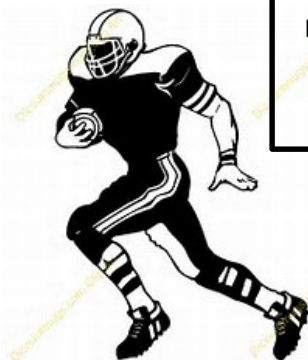
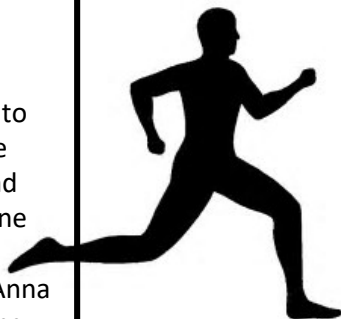


Varsity Boys

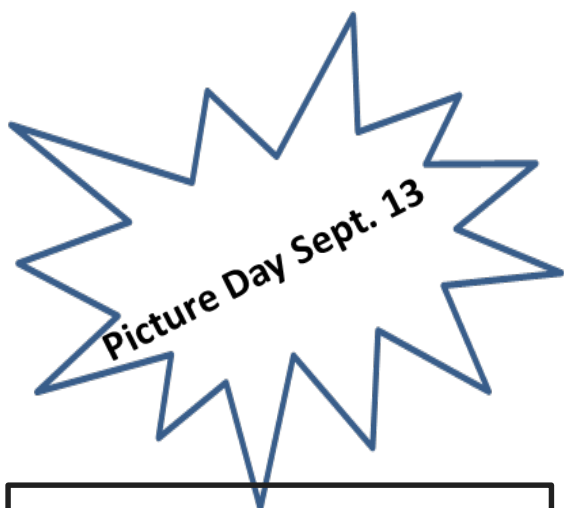
