

Betty Wilson Scholarship Fund

The Betty Wilson Scholarship Fund was established in honor of and in memory of Elizabeth M. (Betty) Wilson who was the spouse of W.C. (Bill) Wilson, daughter of A.F. and Mary Michaels and granddaughter of James and Estella Buzbee. This scholarship was created to encourage May High School graduates to pursue higher education opportunities.

The Betty Wilson Scholarship is a \$1000 scholarship to be awarded in increments of \$500 per semester. Should the recipient of this scholarship desire to attend summer school, the increments would be reduced to \$250 per summer semester. The scholarship may be used to pursue higher learning opportunities offered by technical and trade schools, junior and senior level colleges, and universities. The recipient must be enrolled in a higher education institution on or before the fall semester following their graduation from May High School to receive scholarship funds.

The criteria the committee will consider but not be limited in its selection process is leadership abilities, demonstrated success in curricular and extracurricular activities, other school and community involvement, ability and determination to complete a higher education degree, and financial capabilities.

Requirements

- Must be a May High School graduating senior still enrolled in May High School.
- Must three letters of recommendation
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 at the end of the 5th six weeks of the applicant's senior year.
- Must write a 150 word essay explaining goals and objectives for continuing your education.
- Must be willing to be interviewed by the scholarship committee.
- Must have met the general requirements of the higher education institution the applicant desires to attend.
- Must complete all part requested and answer all questions on the Betty Wilson Scholarship Application. The application must be delivered to the May High Scholl counselor on or before the deadline-Monday, April 1, 2019.

Notification

The recipient of the Betty Wilson Scholarship will be announced during the May High School Commencement Exercises.
