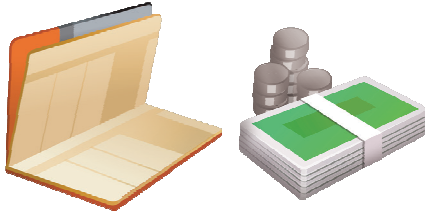


# 3 WAYS TO PAY FOR MEALS



## CHECK OR CASH

## ONLINE
