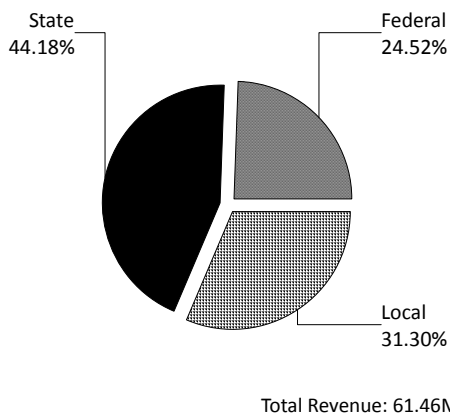

Revenue Sources



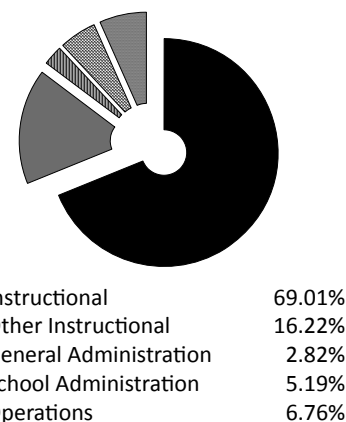
