Our staff uses the newest technology in order to create the stories that appear on our website. To participate in many of the classes, we ask that your child come to camp with a device capable of downloading a photo editing app, **Snapseed**. Snapseed can be found in the App Store and the Google Play Store and is free to download. Please send your child to camp with a phone, tablet, or media device with the app already downloaded. We also ask that you create a Google account for your child. If the child is in MPSD, a Google account is already created and has to be activated. Instructions to activate the account are as followed:

Username/Login: first initial last name and last two digits of PowerSchool ID number (Usually MSIS #)

Ex: Name: Jon Doe Powerschool ID: 123456

Login: idoe56@mpsdconnect.org

Passwords will be first initial, last initial with MSIS number

Ex: jd123456

Please check one of the classes below for your child to be in. All recruits will also participate in a photography session, Photo Editing or Digital Photography.	
Sports Profiling: Children will have the opportunity to interview one or two athletes and write a brief profile about them. They will take pictures of them as well to help create their stories. Children will be asked to create 2 interview questions about their subjects, and other questions will be provided. A template focusing on profiles will be provided for them to follow along with.	Feature Story Writing: Feature writing is a type of writing that deals with more interesting news stories. In news writing you cover the more relevant details, however, in feature writing you learn more about a specific person or thing. In the feature writing session, students will need a notepad, pen/pencil, and their school Google accounts. Students will be taught about feature writing and we will discuss our paper's experience with feature writing. There will be a hands-on activity for students to get a partner and learn cool, interesting, and fun facts about their partner. This activity will enhance feature writing skills and partner skills.
