Please begin your visit with a general meeting in the All Purpose Room. In order to get to the All Purpose Room, please utilize the MAIN ENTRANCE to Joyce Kilmer School located towards the back of the parking lot near the edge of the playground. There will be an overview of special subjects, and brief presentations by various community organizations that assist our students every day.

The PTA will be sponsoring a Scholastic Book Fair throughout the evening at which time you may buy books for your child and purchase gifts for your child's classroom library. The book sale will take place in the glass links hallway between the hours of 6:30 – 8:30 PM. - Period 5 and 6 will be different depending on the grade level of your child. If your child is in grade 6, during the portion of the schedule reading **5/6th Period** then you should go to period 6, as they have lunch period 5. **6th grade goes to Period 6 (They have lunch 5th Period)**
- If your child is in grade 7 or 8, during the portion of the schedule reading **5/6th Period** then you should go to period 5, as they have lunch period 6. **7th and 8th grades go to Period 5 (They have lunch 6th Period)**
