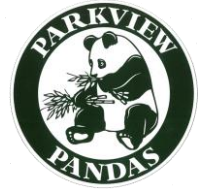




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Summer Projects for Incoming 2nd through 5th graders

Dear Parents/Guardians:

We are excited summer is here, and even more excited to present you with our new summer projects designed for our students entering grades 2 through 5 in September! The summer projects are an option, and not mandatory for the children. Summer reading is embedded into the mini projects and therefore, there are no required summer reading assignments at these grade levels.

These summer projects are meant to engage the students in cross-curricular activities while also being fun, engaging, and thought-provoking. Some of the projects include decorating a “kindness rock” and placing it somewhere in town for someone to find, or submitting a movie review. Students are encouraged to engage with technology by submitting a Flip Grid or designing their own meme! Projects also involve community service with the Milltown Police and Fire Station, or helping to clean up an area of Milltown.

All students will be invited to join a Google Classroom page where 10 mini-projects will be available. They will have the opportunity to choose at least 5 assignments to complete to be eligible for a certificate and a special prize they will receive at the end of the summer!
