Our class generally consists of less than 18 students, several of these students requiring
Special Education Services with the remainder of the students being typically developed 3 and 4 year olds.
The program is led by a dual certified (General and Special Education) Preschool-Grade 3 teacher.

For the 2018-19 school year, there will be both an **AM** and a **PM session** offered five days a week.

The morning session is from **8:20 a.m.-10:50 a.m.** and

the afternoon session is from **12:15 p.m.-2:45 p.m.**
