Integrated Preschool Program

The half day Integrated Preschool Program provides an opportunity for all 3 and 4 year olds to be educated together.

Our classes generally consists of less than 18 students, several of these students requiring Special Education Services with the remainder of the students being typically developing 3 and 4 year olds.

The program is led by a dual certified (General and Special Education) Preschool-Grade 3 teacher.

For the 2019-20 school year, there will be both **AM** and **PM sessions** offered five days a week. The morning session is from **8:20 a.m.-10:50 a.m.** and the afternoon session is from **12:15 p.m.-2:45 p.m.**
