NORMAL CONFLICT

- “Mutually competitive or opposing action or engagement.
- Includes disagreements, arguments and fights.
- A normal part of growing up and of life.

BULLYING

- HIB is one-sided.
- One or more students are victims of one or more person’s aggression, as it applies to the HIB definition under the law.
- The intent is to physically or emotionally hurt someone.
