Dear Eighth Grade Parents and Guardians:

We are excited that the Eighth Grade Banquet will be held at Joyce Kilmer School on Friday, June 1, 2018. The student invitations will be sent home with the students later this month.

Students must be present in school on the day of banquet in accordance with school procedures in order to attend the evening's event. However, students attending the banquet will be permitted an early release time from school beginning at 1:45 pm on the afternoon of June 1<sup>st</sup>. Students must be signed out by an adult. An adult other than a parent may sign out the student as long as we have written permission from the parent/guardian to do so. Students, parents, and guardians are invited to arrive at Joyce Kilmer School beginning at 6:00 pm to allow time for photographs to be taken on the grounds of the school. Students will then be invited to enter the gymnasium beginning at 6:30 pm, but do not have to be inside the venue until 6:50 pm as to allow time for more photo opportunities with parents, relatives, siblings, and friends. By 6:50 pm, all students should be inside the venue to begin the evening's festivities. Parents and guardians should plan to return to Joyce Kilmer at approximately 9:50 pm for the 10:00 pm release time. All students must be accompanied by an adult when leaving the banquet.

Once inside, the students will be transported to their destination *A Knight Around the World* by the wonderful, imaginative, and creative decorations provided by the banquet committee. The students will then be treated to a buffet dinner courtesy of the Milltown PTA, and they will also enjoy music and a photo booth provided by Pro DJ Entertainment.

The suggested acceptable attire for this semi-formal banquet dinner dance for girls may consist of a dressy skirt and top, dress pants and a blouse, or a party dress. Boys may wear dress slacks with a shirt and tie, or a suit. Students are not permitted to wear sneakers, jeans, crop tops, tube tops or miniskirts. Students are encouraged to wear what makes them comfortable for the occasion while remaining appropriate.
