AUDIT PRESENTATION

Mr. Ed McCormick remarked about his findings regarding the audit performed by the offices of Mulcahy, Pauritsch, Salvador & Co., Ltd. of our District's financial records for the Fiscal Year 2010-11. Mr. McCormick provided a closing letter to the Board of Education that was included with the audit document. In all areas, Mokena School District 159 received positive comments. Questions by the Board were asked and answered by Mr. McCormick.

Mr. Peters and Mrs. Moore thanked the district staff for their outstanding efforts on the results of the audit. Dr. Vitton complimented Mr. Hendrick and the staff as well.

FSA PRESENTATION

Ms. Christiana Bock of Mesirow Financial presented competitive Flexible Spending Accounting Administration summary to the Board of Education. Questions by the Board were asked and answered by Ms. Bock. It was suggested by the Board to survey the eligible employees first of the interest; will pursue if there is a great interest in the program.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Finance** Chairman Peters stated the next committee meeting will be October 26, 2011; The tax levy and cash flow analysis will be the focus of the meeting. Future plans to update budget timeline and involving the other committees.
- Policy-Chairman Markham reported the committee met for the first time earlier on October 13 to discuss policy changes in compliance with IASB and adjustments needed on our local policies.
- **Building & Grounds/Transportation-** Chairman Ford reported the committee reviewed the first draft of the public presentation; committee will be meet October 20 to revise and finalized the presentation; Public forum is tentatively scheduled for October 27.
- Parent Advisory- Chairman Spalla and committee will meet November 1, 2011.
- Curriculum Chairman Troy and Dr. Vitton drafted the scope, parameters for this committee:
 - 1. Early Start- will outline the pros and cons for the BOE
 - 2. Kindergarten will research the pros and cons of full and half day programs
- **Technology** Chairman Spalla and **the** committee will meet October 18 to determine short and long term goals in relation to curriculum and technology also look at Board meeting taping etc. Mr. Peters noted that since Mr. Franceschini was already a member of the committee and has now been appointed as a Board member he would be stepping down from the committee to ensure that no Board policies would be violated with more than two Board members serving on a committee.

Mrs. Moore stated again she does not agree with three Board members on a committee. The policy needs to be changed to reflect the maximum of three Board members.

ISAT SCORES

Dr. Vitton presented the District ISAT scores. He explained our students performed exceptionally well; students' scores either held constant or went up in almost every area at every grade level. On average, 86% of our students met or exceeded state standards in Reading and 91% of our students met or exceeded in Mathematics. Our Science scores held relatively constant with 91% of our 4th graders and 86% of our 7th graders meeting or exceeding state standards.

He thanked the staff for their efforts, the students for their hard work and the parents for their continual support. The scores reflect a collaborative effort of all involved in the education of students. Continued to explain ISAT will only be 2013-14; PARCC exam will begin 2014-15 aligned with Common Core standards.

SCHOOL REPORT CARD

A draft of the 2011 Illinois District Report card was provided to the Board. The school improvement plans for each school will be included and ready for publication by the end of October.

ROE ANNUAL LIFE SAFETY REPORT
